

RESOLUTION ON MIGRATORY FLOWS

Due to the massive migratory flows stemming from different causes currently affecting the entire world, facilitating illegal migration and recognizing this human tragedy the IDC-CDI:

- Considers that every person should be guaranteed his or her most fundamental human rights and all existing international safeguards;
- Calls for inter-state collaboration in order to guarantee effective border controls at the global level by all appropriate means.
- Stresses the necessity for states receiving these migratory flows to enable migrants' integration into their respective societies;
- Reaffirms the commanding need to put an end to the trafficking of human beings, to strongly combat the mafias and traffickers involved, and to strengthen support for the protection of those persons victimized by this form of organized crime;
- Insists that, to prevent these great migratory flows, it is necessary to provide increased assistance to migrants' countries of origin, address the root causes of migration and to strengthen collaboration with third countries at the economic, political and institutional level. We will continue to work to achieve this goal with concrete steps.
