

Resolution on Solidarity with the People of Ukraine

1. Firmly supports Ukraine's sovereignty and territorial integrity and condemns the Russian Federation's illegal, unprovoked and unjustified military aggression against and invasion of Ukraine;
2. Demands the Russian Federation to immediately terminate all military activities in Ukraine and unconditionally withdraw all forces and military equipment from the entire internationally recognised territory of Ukraine;
3. Praises the solidarity shown by EU citizens, Member States and the EU itself and expresses gratitude to authorities and citizens of neighbouring countries, in particular, Poland, Hungary, Romania, Slovakia, Republic of Moldova, who - without delay and obstacles - welcomed hundreds of thousands of Ukrainian citizens fleeing the war and provided unprecedented support to people who remained in Ukraine;
4. Urges continued diplomatic efforts to facilitate the peace negotiations between the sides, to foster the end of Russian aggression against Ukraine and to find a peaceful solution based on respect for Ukraine's sovereignty and territorial integrity;
5. Acknowledges Ukraine's European aspirations and welcomes the approval of EU candidate status to Ukraine as a clear political sign of solidarity with the people of Ukraine;
6. Expresses its most profound solidarity with Ukraine and its citizens who have suffered enormous losses, and hopes that peace will soon be achieved, as this is in everyone's interest, and which provides an opportunity to start Ukraine's reconstruction;
7. Emphasizes that Ukraine, as a candidate member to the European Union, must respect the Rule of Law, fulfilling all EU standards on fundamental rights, including minority rights.
