



Resolution on the tragedy in Iran. Innocent deaths demanding urgent and necessary change on behalf of the governing regime.

In the face of the chilling death of over 320 Iranian citizens, including 43 minors, as a result of the government's ill-fated repression of the legitimate protests of a population whose basic rights of expression are being diminished, facing a lack of legal certainty and no protection from the country's own security forces,

The IDC – CDI regrets the death of Mahsa Amini, caused by the brutal and repressive actions while in police custody. The International community sends its condolences to the family and calls on the police authorities to clean up criminal responsibilities for such a shameful “murder”.

The IDC – CDI strongly condemns all human losses from unjustified, brutal, disproportionate, and deplorable police repression. It also sends its condolences to all the people of Iran, expressing our solidarity and support, especially to the families of the victims.

The IDC – CDI demands the unconditional and immediate release of the more than 15,000 detainees who have legitimately attempted to express their frustration and discontent over the death of Madsa Amini, the young Iranian protester. The nation's government must permit its citizens to express their concerns, with full respect for freedom of expression and the press.

The IDC – CDI and all its constituent parties and governments demand the following of the Irani government and those responsible for the judiciary,

- 1.- Whereby the failure to apply the death penalty, especially in the face of the publication by international media, that 20 detained activists are sitting on the judicial bench, awaiting this inhuman sentence.
- 2.- Immediately order the law forces to act with respect for all human rights, which Iranian citizens deserve.
- 3.- All arbitrary detentions shall be without effect, and furthermore, every detainee shall be ensured the right to a public, impartial, fair, and transparent judicial process, with controlled and guaranteed police custody of a minimum duration.
- 4.- The free convening and holding of peaceful demonstrations by all citizens shall be permitted. The government is reminded of the need to listen to civil society and its duty to serve the people, to respond to their requests, given that they are the true owners of the destiny of their lives, being the legitimate and sole holders of national sovereignty.
5. The halting of the unjustified involvement in Putin's war against Ukraine, and the immediate cessation of the shipment of warfare material and drones, which it has recognized as having been sent to the Russian troops, given the detriment that this has caused on the civil population.
