



Public Statement of the Centrist Democrat International (IDC-CDI):

The IDC-CDI condemns foreign interference aimed at destabilizing Milei

In light of the Urgency and Necessity Decree (DNU) proposed by President Javier Milei, with the aim of rectifying an economy shattered by the previous government, the international left has unleashed a wave of attacks, intervening in Argentina's internal affairs.

It is a serious and alarming fact that the Sao Paulo Forum and the Progressive International have promoted the general strike called by some local unions against the DNU, held on January 24. Despite the failure of the strike, the improper interference of these two leftist platforms is unacceptable.

The motivations of the Sao Paulo Forum and the Progressive International are hypocritical because if they truly wanted to defend democracy and the interests of workers, they would be condemning the dictatorial regimes of Cuba, Nicaragua, and Venezuela, where citizens suffer under the harsh rule of tyrants.

The IDC-CDI expresses its full support for the government and the people of Argentina and urges the democratic sectors of the West to condemn the international left's plans to destabilize President Milei.
