

## Resolution on Enhancing Peace, Tolerance and Reconciliation

We the Centrist Democrats International (CDI) are deeply concerned about the ongoing challenges and threats to global peace and security, including social and political instability, in many parts of the world. Those challenges and threats have become formidable in countless ways, affecting the progress, happiness, and unity of humanity and importantly producing grave social and economic consequences for generations to come.

Realising the fragility of global peace which is one of the precursors for the decline in human civilisations, we hereby raise our voices and galvanize our collective strengths to promote peace, tolerance and reconciliations among societies and nations.

- We appreciate the CDI's leadership for initiating an internal functional mechanism to work on promoting the values and peace as a stepping stone and foundation to project our collective influence on achieving lasting peace and inclusive development in across the continents, namely Asia, Europe, Africa, the America, and Latin America on the basis of international law, especially the sovereignty of states and non-violations of the borders.
- We aim to galvanize a critical mass of international support and solidarity such that the world acts in unison to curtail the intensifying tensions and address these challenges.
- We strive to further promote social and inter-faith harmony and value-based social progress by upholding freedoms and by advocating for democratic values, the rule of law, justice, and effective governance.
- We therefore call for enhanced approaches to peacebuilding, active and proactive conflict prevention, and win-win solutions and reconciliations in all domestic and international conflicts by encouraging parties in conflicts to resort to the use of nonviolence, non-aggression and non-provocation.
- We also call for the establishment of a global architecture for peacebuilding, confliction prevention, reconciliation and post-conflict prevention in leveraging the constructive roles of governments, parliaments, political parties, private sector and civil society organisations as an operational mechanism to promote the values and peace in support of the UN agenda for peace and sustainable development.
