

### **Resolution on the current situation in Angola**

- Noting the setback in the quality of democracy in Angola;
- Looking at the clear intention of the current President of the Republic to amend the Constitution to illegally impose a third term;
- Noting the fact that control and manipulation of the judiciary are a common practice in Angola;
- Considering that all members of the IDC-CDI family regularly participate in elections.

The IDC-CDI:

- 1- Recommends to the Angolan Government and the Angolan Institutions linked to it scrupulous respect for the Rule of Law, respect for human rights, and promote transparency in the management of public affairs;
- 2- Calls for the creation of a structure to monitor the implementation of all resolutions approved by the Executive Committee;
- 3- Advises that future meetings of the Executive Committee include assessments of the levels of compliance with the decisions taken;
- 4- Repeats the need for the urgent creation of the IDC-CDI Electoral Observatory, to help monitor and carry out free, democratic and transparent elections.
- 5- Reaffirms the need for member parties to move their influence in their democratic parliament, legislation that punishes governments worldwide that resort to constitutional coups to remain in power;
- 6- Condemns the political violence against a delegation of UNITA MPs, perpetrated by members of the ruling Party during an official visit and asks the Government to take proper measures against the moral and material authors of the crimes.
