

Resolution on the Humanitarian Crisis and the Defense of Democratic Principles in Gaza

Reaffirming its unwavering commitment to democracy, human dignity, and the protection of innocent civilian lives,

Recalling that the current tragic conflict was ignited on 7 October 2023, when the terrorist group Hamas launched a brutal attack on Israel, killing over 1,200 people and abducting more than 250, including women and children,

Condemning the destabilizing role of Iran's proxy networks in fueling regional violence and undermining democratic values,

Recognizing that the civilian population of Gaza is a double victim—suffering under Hamas' oppressive rule and the consequences of ongoing military operations,

Deeply concerned by the humanitarian emergency in Gaza, where over two million people face life-threatening shortages, including starvation.

The IDC-CDI hereby resolves:

1. **Condemns** the terrorist attacks of 7 October 2023 by Hamas and demands the immediate, unconditional release of all hostages.
2. **Expresses deep solidarity** with all innocent victims of the conflict, both Israeli and Palestinian, and mourns the loss of civilian lives, particularly children.
3. **Denounces the role of Iran and its proxies** in enabling and supporting extremist violence, and calls for international action to curb their influence in the region.
4. **Affirms Israel's right to self-defense**, while urging strict adherence to international humanitarian law to protect civilian lives in all military operations.
5. **Recognizes the people of Gaza as victims of the war between Hamas and Israel**, and demands the urgent, safe, and sufficient delivery of humanitarian aid, ensuring it reaches the civilian population.
6. **Calls for a sustained ceasefire** and the launch of a credible diplomatic process to secure peace, dignity, freedom, and security for both Israelis and Palestinians.
7. **Urges consistency in international responses to human rights abuses**, and reaffirms the IDC-CDI's global commitment to peace, democracy, and the defense of innocent lives against terrorism and oppression.
8. **Reaffirms its unwavering support for the two-state solution as the only viable path** to lasting peace.
